by acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said Berulah Riddle her heirs and assigns forever, all of that certain piece, parcel and lot of land, situated in the State and County aforesaid, adjoining lands of J. A.
