 County of Greenville, South Carolina, having the following course and distance, to wit:
 Beginning at an iron stake, where the west side of Pettigree Street intersects
 the south side of North Street, and running thence with the said North
 Street, S. 69° N. 106 feet to an iron stake, thence S. 15° E. 152 feet to an iron stake
 in an alley, thence with said alley N. 76° 3/4 E. 41' 3" to a work stake, west side of
 Pettigree Street, thence with Pettigree Street N. 15° E. 178' 7" to the beginning, being
