Owens in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Robert G. Owens

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the second ward of the City of Greenville: Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of East Stone Avenue, one hundred and ten feet east of Rowley Street, and running thence with said Stone Avenue S. 72-09 E. fifty-one and one-half feet to an iron pin; thence S. 20 W. one hundred seventy-five feet to an iron pin; thence along line parallel with Stone Avenue N. 72-09 W. fifty-one and one-half feet to an iron pin; thence N. 20 E. one hundred seventy-five feet to the beginning corner, as shown by plat made by Will D. Neves, July 2nd, 1915.

Woodside's line (formerly Alex Finlay's) lot on Washington Street, thence along Woodside's line one hundred and fifty-three (153) feet to an iron pin at corner of G. B.
