AND WHEREAS, the said Board of Corporators, on the 20th day of February 1915, did file with the Secretary of
State their return in writing, over their signatures, certifying, among other things, that pursuant to publish notice as required in the commission of the said
Corporators, the books of subscription to the capital stock of the aforesaid Company were duly opened, and that thereupon exceeding fifty per centum of the capital
stock was subscribed by bona fide stockholders; that thereupon a meeting of stockholders was called, and the aforesaid Company duly organized by the election of
a Board of Directors and other necessary officers. That, furthermore, they have complied with all the requirements of the Code of Laws of the State of South
Carolina of 1912, and all Acts or parts of Acts amendatory theret;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, R.M. McCown Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid
Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and
for the purpose indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that
a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance in each county where such Corporation shall have a business
office.
