WHEREAS, W. H. Newton, J. O. Luntz, Jr. and  
R. D. & Barksdale, all of Greenville, S. C.  
did on the 4th day of February, 1916 file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration, signed by themselves, setting forth:

First: The names and residences of the said petitioners to be as above given.

Second: The name of the proposed corporation be that of  
Greenville - Carolina Trust Company

Third: The principal place of business of the corporation will be  
Greenville, S. C.

Fourth: The general purpose of the corporation, and the nature of business it proposes to do.

*Decrease recorded February 24, 1924*  
That of lending money, buying and selling notes, bonds, debentures, mortgages, stocks, and other securities; negotiating loans, acting as trustee of property, stocks, bonds, mortgages, and other securities; acting as insurer and guarantors of titles to real estate, with power to guarantee the payment of any security or obligations sold by it, or negotiated, through it; borrow money and secure the same by certificates of deposit, notes, bonds, or otherwise; receive money on deposit, buy and sell real estate, to act as executor, administrator and trustee of estate and other funds and with right and power to do all things usual to a trust company.

Fifth: The amount of the capital stock to be  
One Hundred Thousand (\$100,000.00)

and the number of shares into which the same is to be divided to be  
One Thousand (1000)

Sixth: The capital stock to be payable as set forth in the Declaration and Petition.  
of the par value of One Hundred (\$100.00) dollars each.

AND WHEREAS, on the 4th day of February, A. D. 1916, the date above named, petitioners were commissioned by me a Board of Corporators;

AND WHEREAS, the said Board of Corporators, on the 19th day of February, 1916, did file with the Secretary of State their return in writing, over their signatures, certifying, among other things, that pursuant to publish notice as required in the commission of the said Corporators, the books of subscription to the capital stock of the aforesaid Company were duly opened, and that thereupon exceeding fifty per centum of the capital stock was subscribed by bona fide stockholders; that thereupon a meeting of stockholders was called, and the aforesaid Company duly organized by the election of a Board of Directors and other necessary officers. That, furthermore, they have complied with all the requirements of the Code of Laws of the State of South Carolina of 1912, and all Acts or parts of Acts amendatory thereto;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, R. M. McCover Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purpose indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
