J. Holmes, Z. L. Holmes, Oscar E. Taylor, W. D. Reynolds, and Paul F. Beacham, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,) havw granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release all our rights and Title-legal and equitable unto the said N. J. Holmes Z. L. Holmes, Oscar E. Taylor, W. D. Reynoldes and Paul E Beacham, as Trustees. All that piece, parcel and tract of land, situate, lying and being in Co Greenville County, South Carolina, on waters of Reedy River and Mountain Creek, waters of Enoree River and having the following lines, metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at a pile of stones 3x 0mM, originally a red Oak, on the Paris Mountain Road and running thence S. 23 E. 16.50 to a stone 3x O.M.gone relocated stone 3x N.M.; thence S. 89 2 E. 73.00 passing a rock 3x 0.M. between two rocks to a stone 3x N.M.
