Bramlett, his heirs and assigns, from all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being on the Laurens Road in Greenville County, South Carolina, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a post Oak Stump on the Laurens Road, and running thence N. 14- $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 30.51 chains to a stake; thence S. 76- $\frac{3}{4}$ E. 1.05 to a stake 50 feet from the center of the track of the C. & W.C. Railroad; thence in a line 50 feet from the center of said railroad S. 37- $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 29.50 chains to a stake; thence S. 14 W. 1.50; thence S. 51- $\frac{3}{4}$ W. 18.84 chains to a stake on the Laurens Road; thence with the Laurens Road N. 53- $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 14.56 chains to the beginning corner and containing 55.24 acres, according to a plat and survey made by W.A.
