

(Right of way for Sewer Line)

State of South Carolina,
Greenville County.

I, hereby permit the United States to lay sewer lines over and under my land in Greenville County, South Carolina, for the use of the troops of the United States at Camp Sevier, Paris, S.C., or other military purposes.

Also for the purpose of constructing and repairing the said lines to grant free ingress and egress to the United States and Its Agents.

The said sewer lines shall be of proper size and construction and maintained in a sanitary condition, and shall be kept at such distance below the surface as shall permit of cultivation of soil wherever practicable.

The United States shall have the right to remove the line when the camp is removed.

Any damage to property or crops now or hereafter planted on said land shall be paid for at a price to be agreed upon, and if such cannot be arrived at, then the damage shall be determined by arbitrators, one to be chosen by me, one by the United States, and the two so appointed to select the third, the decision of any two of the three arbitrators to be final.
