 Received from Postal Telegraph Cable
 Co. Five ^{no} \$500 (500) in consideration
 of which I hereby grant unto said Company
 its successors and assigns, the right
 to construct and maintain its lines
 of Telegraphs including the necessary poles
 and fixtures over the property which
 I own, or in which I have any interest
 in the Township of Oak Lawn County of
 Greenville and State of South Carolina and
 along the roads, streets or highways adjoining
 the said property, with the right to trim all
 trees necessary to keep the wires cleared at
 least eighteen inches, to set necessary guy
 and brace poles, and to attach to trees the
 necessary guy wires. Line to be built not to
 exceed 4 feet from road line, two trees to be
 trimmed.
