Know All men by these presents, That W.W. Glenn of said County and State, in consideration of the premises, and of the sum of Thirty & 00/100 dollars to me in hand paid by the City of Greenville, South Carolina, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant unto the said City of Greenville, its successors and assigns, the right, privilege and easement to go in and upon that tract of land, situated in said County and State, bounded by lands of W.C. Crumley on the north, Tate, Meese & J.H. Batson on the east, Mrs. M.P. Bradley on the south, and Mrs. M.P. & A. Bradley on the west and to construct and maintain in, upon and through said premises, in a proper manner, with poles, towers, wires and other necessary apparatus and appliances, lines for the purpose of transmitting power by electricity and telephone service, together with the right at all times, to enter upon said premises for the purpose of inspecting said lines, and making necessary repairs and alterations thereon; together with the right to cut away and keep clear of said lines, all trees and other like obstructions that may in any way, endanger the proper oprration of the same. The payment above specified is accepted in full settlement of all claims for said easement. Any damages to crops planted, shall be paid for at a price to be agreed upon, and if such can not be arrived at mutuslly, the damage shall be determined by arbitrators, one to be chosen by me, one by the holder of this grant, and the two so appointed, to select a third.

The decision of any two of the three arbitrators shall be final. The above right-of-way is granted for said power line to be located 150 feet east of the house over which the present survey runs- All wood cut on the above right of way is to be corded neatly and ready for market If more than ten poles are placed on the above premises I am to receive three dollars for each additional pole.

Know all men by these presents, That I, Lorena Huff of said County and State in consideration of the premises, and of the sum of Fifty & 00/100 Dollars to me in hand paid by the City of Greenville, South Carolina, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant unto the said City of Greenville, its successors and assigns, the right, privilege and easement to go in and upon that tract of land, situated in said County and State, bounded by lands of Minnie Styles estate & Maggie-Bradley on the north, J.D. Garrett on the east, A.H. Whitmire and Cheve Brown on the South & Billy Turner on the west and to construct and maintain in, upon and through said premises, in a proper manner, with necessary apparatus and appliances, a pipe line for the purpose of conveying water under pressure, from the Auxiliary pumping station on the Enorge River to the main pipe line leading to the City, from reservoir number three, of the Paris Mountain Water Co., together with the right at all times to enter upon said premises for the purpose of inspecting said line, and making necessary repairs and alterations thereon; together with the right to cut away and keep clear of said pipe line all trees and other like obstructions that may in any way, endanger the Proper operation of the same.

The payment above specified is accepted in full settlement of all claims for said easement. Any damages to crops planted, shall be paid for at a price to be agreed upon, and is such can not be arrived at mutually, the damage shall be determined by arbitrators, one to be chosen by me, one by the holder of this grant, and the two so appointed, to select a third.
