Davis of Greenville County Dunklin Township in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Fifteen hundred eighty-two and 50/100 DOLLARS, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by B.G. McAlister (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said B.G. McAlister, all that tract or plot of land lying and being in Greenville County...

Dunklin Township, containing fifty-two and three-fourths acres (52-3/4), bounded as follows by lands of W.M. Ridgeway, Jones and others: Beginning on a stone on Public Road near Pine-Hill School house; thence 11-1/2° West 10.80 along the road to stone at Mail Box; thence N. 4 W. 11.70 chs. to point in the road; thence N. 64-1/2° E. 8.00 to point; thence N. 45-1/2° E. 1.79 chs. to point at head of branch; thence down the branch to Cherry on Branch; thence N. 53-1/2° down the said branch to a stone at the fork of the branch following the meanders thereof as the line; thence down the branch to a stone near the mouth of the branch on line of tract #5; thence S. 53-1/2° W. 30.00 ch. to the beginning corner, containing 52-3/4 acres, known as the Letimer Land.
