

Docia Cashion DEED TO J.B. Patterson, et-l. THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA, COUNTY OF Greenville

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Docia Cashion in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Two hundred sixty-five DOLLARS, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J.B. and Hulda Patterson (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said J.B. and Hulda Patterson, All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, being located in Section known as Fallis and being known as lot No. 2, of Section 2, according to a plat of Fallis Annex made by W.D. Neves, C.E. and recorded in office of R.M.C. for Greenville County in plat hook "C", page 100 and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a stake on Bradley St., joint corners of Lots Nos. 2 and 3 and running thence S. 64-30 W. 320 feet to a stake, corner of lots 2, 3, 18 and 19; thence N. 24 W. 100 feet to a stake; thence N. 64-30 E. 320 feet to a stake on Bradley Street; thence with said Bradley Street S. 24 E. 100 feet to the beginning point.
