in consideration of the sum of ten dollars and other considerations DOLLARS,

H.G. Copeland (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said H.G. Copeland, All that certain piece, parcel and lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, Chick Springs Township on the South side of the Buncombe Road, adjoining lands of H.G. Copeland, Henry Taylor and others, and having the following courses and distances: Beginning on a stone in old post-oak stump, gone and runs thence N. 13-1/2 W. 2.96 chs. to a stake in the said Buncombe Road; thence with the said road as line S. 84 E. 5.21 chs. to a bend; thence S. 77-1/2 E. 7.91 chs. to a stake in the said road, Henry Taylors corner; thence S. 54 W. 7.26 chs. to a stone, Henry Taylors and H.G. Copelands corner; thence N. 61-1/2 W. 7.50 chs. to the beginning corner, containing Four and forty-three (4.43) acres, more or less. The courses for the last two lines were taken from R.L.
