H.M. Barton (the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the
said H.M. Barton All my interest in that piece and parcel or tract of land situate,
lying and being in State and County above named, being a part of a tract of land deeded by
N.G. Boling to H.M. Barton and W.Y. McDaniel the same being in Chick Springs Township on the
south side of the Southern Railroad and on Marrow Bone branch, waters of Enoree River and
bounded by lands of Charles Wynn and H.M. Barton, having the following metes and bounds Viz:
Beginning At railroad and running South S. 10 to a stake X; thence S. 22 E. 11.3 to a white
oak on bank of Marrowbone Branch; thence up meanders of said branch to Walter Smiths line at
road leading from Chick Springs road to Brush Creek Church, and thence N. 19 E. 2 C X; thence
