Bridges, of the County of Greenville in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Twenty-five hundred (\$2500.00) DOLLARS, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Mrs. Sarah Buriss McDaniel (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the Mrs. Sarah Buriss McDaniel, her heirs and assigns: All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the City and County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, in Ward five on the South side of Garlington Street and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Commencing at an iron pipe on the South side of Garlington Street, corner of lot of Mrs. Plyler said pipe being 106 feet from the west side of Leach Street; thence along the South side of Garlington Street N. 71.15 W. 50 ft. to an iron pipe; thence along line of Mrs. Sullivan's property S. 17-20 W. 136 ft. to a stake on rear line; thence along rear line of lots S. 70.07 E. 50 feet to an iron pin; thence along line of Mrs. Plyler's lot N. 17-20 E. 137 ft. to the point of beginning, and being the same lot of land conveyed to me by H.W.
