NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Lula F. Wood of the State of Kentucky... in consideration of the sum of One hundred and eight and 35/100 DOLLARS,

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by R.H. Vaughan, of the State of S.C. (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said R.H. Vaughan, and his heirs and assigns, All of my right, title and undivided interest estate, claim and demand, both at law and in Equity, which I now have or may hereafter in any manner acquire, whether by inheritance or otherwise, of in and to all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville, on Brushy Creek, waters of Enoree River, in Butler Township, and having subh metes and bounds as appear in a deed from Wiley Kemp to D.L. Vaughan, said deed is recorded in deed book CC, at page 532 in the R.M.C. Office for said County and State to which reference is hereby made. Said tract of land containing 102 acres, more or less. This deed being intended by me, the said Lula F. Wood to convey all of my right, title and interest of every nature and kind in the land hereinabove named unto the said R.H. Cureton, of Greenville City and County in consideration of the sum of Twenty-eight hundred (\$2800.00) DOLLARS, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by A.L. Thompson of the State aforesaid (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said A.L. Thompson, his heirs and assigns, All of that certain piece, parcel and tract of land situated on the East side of Middle Tyger River, partly in Spartanburg and Greenville Counties and State aforesaid, adjoining lands of Dudley Williams, Southrs and others and conveyed to me by T.J. Cureton and recorded in Register of Mesne Conveyance Vol. 23, page 127 for Greenville County and by T.J.
