Monteith, All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, and being known as lot #61 on plat of property of Wilkins Cagle made by J.E. 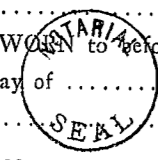
