NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Mary E. Snyder
in the State aforesaid
in consideration of the sum of Five (\$5.00) Dollars and other considerations
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

T.A. Snyder (the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the
said T.A. Snyder, All that piece, parcel and tract of land containing Fifty-six acres, more

or less, situated, lying and being in Gantt Township, County and State aforesaid, about five
miles south of Greenville Court House on both sides of the Stanton Bridge Road, and having the
following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a stone 3Xom, in a road on what was formerly
known as the Cooper land (now belonging to the Dandy negroes) and running thence S. 5-1/4 W.
21.50 to a poplar 3Xom struck by lightning and dead, at the head of a branch; thence down said
branch as a line S. 17-3/4 W. 9.72 to a sourwood 3Xom, on another branch; thence up said
branch as a line to a black oak 3Xom; thence N. 41-1/3 E. 17.18 to a black oak 3Xom; thence
N. 59-1/8 E. 16.29 to a white-oak 3Xom on Payns' Mill Creek; thence up the creek as a line
about 14.00 to a black gum 3Xom; thence N. 67-1/4 W. 2.00 to a stone 3Xom; thence S. 83 W. 22.00
to the beginning corner. Adjoining land of Henry Payne, Judge Yancy, Chas. Satterfield (part of
estate of Jno. Satterfield) and others. This being the tract of land conveyed to the said
