in consideration of the sum of one hundred and twenty-five (\$125.00) DOLLARS,
to J.F. White in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J.F. White (the receipt whereof

is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, sold and Released and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said J.F. White, his heirs and assigns, All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, about two miles West of Greenville Court-house and being a portion of a sub-division known as City View: Beginning at a stake on the New Cut Road and Henderson Street and running thence North 30 E. 86 ft. to a stake, joint corners of lots Nos. 88 & 89 and running; thence with joint lines of said lots in a westernly direction 150 ft. to a stake on an alley; thence in a Southernly direction in line with said alley 103 ft. to a stake on the new cut road; thence with line of said road in an easternly direction 150 ft. to a stake at the beginning corner, being known as Lots Nos. 89 & 90 according to a plat made by W.A. Meares & Son Nos. 8, 10 & 12 of the index lands and designated as 204 of the basic maps according to a survey & plat made by J.M. Adams dated Sept. 15, 1871. Beginning on a W.C.
