is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, sold and Released and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

I.L. Godfrey, All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the
State and County aforesaid, about 2-1/2 miles southwest of the City of Greenville, in the
vicinity of Fallis and being designated as lot No. 5, Section 1, of the Fallis Annex according
to plat thereof, recorded in the office of the R.M.C. for Greenville County in Plat Book C.
page 101 and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a pin on the West
side of Whitehorse Road 252 feet from the corner of Earle's Drive, and running thence S.
64-30 W. 200 feet to the common corner of lots 4, 5 and 24 and 25; thence along the line of
lot #24, S. 24 E. 63 feet to corner of lots 5, 6, and 24 and 23; thence with line of lot

W.R. Charles, All those two certain pieces, parcels or lots of land situate, lying and being
in the State and County aforesaid, about two miles Southwest of the City of Greenville, in
vicinity of Fallis, and being known and designated as lots Nos. 5 & 6, Section 1, of Fallis
Annex as shown by plat made by W.D. Neves, C.E. March 1913 and recorded in plat Book "C", at
