Benjamin Knigoff his heirs and assigns, forever, all that piece, parcel and lot of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, on the east side of Townes Street and hath the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin on East side of Townes Street, corner of lot of T.G. Crymes and running thence along Townes Street S. 16 W. 50.3 feet to iron pipe on Townes Street; thence S. 72 E. 199 feet to an Alley; thence along the Alley N. 18 E. 50.3 feet to corner of lot of T.G.
