A. Allen, Clara Vaughan and Silas Pool

in the State aforesaid

Forty Three DOLLARS,  
to us in hand paid  
at and before the sealing of these presents by Samuel B. McDaniel

in the State aforesaid (the receipt whereof  
is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said  
Samuel B. McDaniel, All our right, title, interest and estate in and to all and singular, all  
that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being within the Corporate limits of the  
City of Greenville, S.C. the same being that lot of land owned by Conrad Pool at the time of his  
death and being the same lot described in the deed of Mary Jane Sloan to the said Conrad Pool  
of date 23rd day of January 1882, recorded in Book R. R. page 646 and being a part of the lot of  
land conveyed by May H. Thompson to Conrad Pool and Mary Jane Sloan on the 28th day of Sept. 1881  
recorded in Book N.N. at page 189, and for courses and distances, metes and bounds reference is  
here made to said deeds.
