is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

E.P. Vaughn, his heirs and assigns, All that piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid on Cane Creek and Enoree River, and is portion of the J.T. Vaughn estate known as Lot No. 5, and has the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at large stooping poplar o.m. near branch and running thence N. 25-30 E. 37 chs. to maple (gone) on bank of Enoree River; thence up said Enoree River to mouth of Cane Creek; thence up said Cane Creek to stake corner n.m. at corner of lot No. 4; thence with said lot No. 4, S. 20 E. 23.75 to an i.p., corner of lot No. 4; thence with said road 19.80 to i.p. in Greer Road; thence S. 70 E. 5.00 chs. to stone corner; thence N. 62-10 E. 13.20 to beginning corner and containing eighty-one (81) acres, more or less, and bounded by lots No. 4, 5, and Green estate and others.
