KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Henry Mason of Greenville County

in the State aforesaid

(the receipt whereof

is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said Sorney Mason, and his heirs and assigns, all of that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville, in Gantt Township, on Brush Creek, waters of Reedy River, and having the following metes and bounds, according to a plat made by R.E. Dalton, Engr. dated December, 1914 to wit: Beginning at a stake in the Old Augusta Road, and running thence S. 83-55 W 309 feet to an iron pin in P.O. Stump; thence S. 17-35 W. 850 feet to an iron pin on Brush Creek; thence following the old run of said Creek as a line to the mouth of a branch; thence following the said branch as a line to an iron pin (A Travelers line as follows, to wit: S. 14-55 W. 103 feet; thence S 8-0 W. 108 feet; thence N 84-45 W 205 feet; thence N 72-15 W. 273 feet; thence N 47 W. 113 feet; thence N. 49-25 W. 94 feet; thence S 78-25 W. 244 feet; thence S 79 W 98 feet; thence S 75-15 W. 93 feet; thence S. 76-50 W 68 feet) on said branch; thence S 19-0 E. 1800 feet, to a stone; thence S. 33-45 E. 732 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 40-30 E 444 feet to an iron pipe; thence N. 51-30 W. 809 feet to an iron pin; thence S 79-07 W 126 feet to an iron pin; thence in a parallel line with Sam Owens property N 19-0 W. 654 feet to an iron pin in a Plantation Road; thence said road the line as follows, to wit; N. 31-34 E. 409 feet to a bend in said Plantation road; thence N 83-50 E. 224 feet to a bend in said road; thence S. 87-08 E. 139 feet to a bend in said road; thence N 83-07 E 105 feet to a bend in said road; thence N 38-17 W. 280 feet to a bend in said road; thence N. 15-35 E. 390 feet (crossing Brushy Creek) to a bend in said road; thence N 35-23 E 510 feet to an iron pin in said road; thence leaving said road N. 48-30 E. 393 feet to a stake-- in Augusta Road; thence along said old and new Augusta Roads N. 51-10 W. 198 feet to the beginning corner, and containing 25.3 acres, more or less, bounded by lands of H.B. Tindal, Sam Owens, J.C. Milford and Henry Mason; this being a portion of the same land conveyed to us, the said Henry Mason and Sorney Mason by Samuel Owens, by his deed dated 23rd. day of August, 1883 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for said County and State in Book "O.O." of deeds at page 486; the interest therein of Sorney Masons having been heretofore conveyed to me, the said Henry Mason by him by his deed bearing date January fifth, 1915, and not yet recorded.
