S.D. Campbell, all those three tracts or parcels of land, situate, lying and being in Greenville County, State aforesaid, and described as follows:

Tract No. 1: All that piece, parcel and lot of land, situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, adjoining the Augusta Road, and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning on a stone Xiii; thence N. 82-1/2 W. 30.50 to a stone Xiii; thence N. 68 W. 45.49 to a stone Xiii; on the Creek; thence S. 30 W. 3.75; thence S. 30 W. 3.50 to a stone Xiii; thence S. 30 W. 27.50 to a stone Xiii; thence S. 31 E. 7.75 to a stone Xiii; thence - 63-1/2 E. 24.50 to a stone; thence S. 82-1/2 E. 21.28 to a stone Xiii on the Augusta Road; thence along said road N. 8 E. 17.00 to the beginning corner; being the same lot of land conveyed to me by J.T.T. Ellison by deed dated Feb. 2, 1885, and recorded in Book Q.Q. 629, and containing Ninety-eight and three-fourths (98-3/4) acres, more or less, the above description being that taken from the record of said deed in R.M.C.
