 is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said
B. P. Mitchell, all that tract of land in the County and
 State aforesaid, in said Township, having the follow-
 ing metes and bounds; Commencing at a stone at cor-
 ner of property of Mrs. Nora B. McDaniel; thence with line
 of Mrs. McDaniel's property North 27-0 East six hundred
 Seventeen (617) feet to a stake near a Hickory tree;
 thence with line of said property North 3-0 East five
 hundred sixty-one (561) feet to a stake on line of W. C.
 Garrison's property; thence with line of Garrison's property
 North 88-24 West Sixty and 3/10 (60.3) feet to an iron pin;
 thence with line of same, by feet North 66-30 West one
 thousand six hundred fifty-five (10,65) feet to an iron pin; thence
 North 5-0 East four hundred twenty-three (423) feet along
 line of Garrison's property to a stone corner of Robert
 Rosamond property; thence with line of Rosamond
 property North 85-145 West five hundred sixty-four
 (564) feet to a stake, thence by a zig-zag line east
 11-40 East twenty-one hundred thirty-five (2135) feet
 to a stake on line of Mrs. McDaniel's property; thence
 along line of said property North 85-30 East eight
 hundred seventy-four (874) feet to the stone at the
 point of beginning, same containing forty-five and
 9/10 acres, more or less, surveyed September 1916,
