is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said Lawrence C. Ashmore his heirs and assigns, all of that certain piece parcel and lot of land situated in the State and County aforesaid, on Reedy River about one mile below Coopers Mills, and being Lot No. 4 in the division of Jacob Lenderman's Estate and more fully described by a plat made by Thos D. Threlkeld on 14th January 1876, and having the following metes and bounds; Beginning at a Red Oak dead 3 ft. on the west bank of Reedy River and running thence S. 30° W. 23.87 chains to a Rock 3 x 3 x 12. m., thence S. 52° 44' E. 21.50 to rock 3 x 3 x 12. m. 8 links from Hickory on Reedy River, thence up the meanders of said river to the beginning point, containing forty-three acres, 3 rods and 1/10 poles more or less.
