is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said Linwood Land & Investment Company, all that piece parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State aforesaid, about 2 1/2 miles west of the City of Greenville, on the North side of the Finley Bridge Road, having the following metes and bounds: one lot known on a survey made by J. W. Southern D. S. as lot No. 7; Beginning at a stake "3x" on the back line, 105 feet of a 36 foot street, and running thence S. 9 3/4 West with line of lot No. 6 to a stake "3x" on Finley Bridge Road, 210 feet on street, thence along said street S. 80 1/4 E. 105 feet to a stake "3x" on said street, thence with said line N. 80 1/4 W. 105 feet to the beginning. Bounded on the north by Finley's land, West by lot No. 6, East by lot No. 8 and south by Finley Bridge Road, and being the same lot of land conveyed to J. R. Orr and D. B. Troxler by H. A.
