KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That

I, Hendrix (Rector)

in the State aforesaid

in consideration of the sum of

Ten Dollars and 77 cent good and valuable consideration DOLLARS,
to me

in hand paid

at and before the sealing of these presents by

R. J. Rowley

(the receipt whereof

is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

(R. J. Rowley), all that certain tract of land situate
 lying and being in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and
 having the following metes and bounds, to wit, Beginning at a point
 foot on Mulberry St., and extending back to lot front
 of former lot one of lots R. R. Beaufort against him at the same day con-
 veyed to me by Justice L. Hill May, and deed platted March 5th 1910 and recorded in R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol.
 5, page 776. All that piece of land so described, in the State
 and County aforesaid, near Birmingham Mill and having
 the following metes and bounds to wit, Beginning at a point
 on the East side of Branyon Road and running thence west
 Branyon Road 12. 13 1/4 ft 70 feet to an iron post, thence S. 84 E.
 175 feet to an iron post, thence S. 77 1/4 E. 75 feet to an iron post,
 thence N. 14 1/4 E. 171 feet to iron post on Branyon Road, the
 beginning corner being lot No. 2 of the Maryland Mill property
 staying at the same left of lot and conveyed to John W. Martin
 and Hendrix (Rector) by Mrs. John Bushlock Grimes by her deed
 dated June 30th, 1904, and recorded in R. M. C. office for
 Greenville County in Vol. 27 page 116. The one-half interest
 of the said John W. Martin having been conveyed to me,
 the said Hendrix (Rector) by his deed dated Sept 1st 1914,
 and recorded in R. M. C. office for Greenville County in
 Vol. 26, page 360. All that piece, parcel or lot of land
 situate, lying and being in Greenville City, Greenville
 County, South Carolina, on May and File Rice Streets
 and, being lots 4 and 5, as appears on a plat made
 by H. D. Moore, Jan 9th, 1911, the same being recorded in
 the office of R. M. C. for Greenville County, in Plat Book "C"
 at page 200. Beginning at an iron post on Wilkins Street
 at the first corner of lots Nos. 3 and 4 and running thence
 with Wilkins St. S. 87-35 1/4 N. 100 feet to an iron post at the
 joint corner of lots Nos. 5 and 6, thence with lot No. 6 N.
 3-15 1/4 170 1/4 feet to an iron post on May Street thence
 with May Street N. 86-15 E. 100 feet to an iron post;
 thence S. 3-15 E. 170 1/4 feet to the beginning and being the
 same lots of land conveyed to me, the said Hendrix (Rector)
 by H. L. Carson, by his deed dated June 4th, 1915 and re-
 corded in R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 27
 page 566.
