KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That

T. B. Bramlett

in the State aforesaid

in consideration of the sum of

to me in hand paid

at and before the sealing of these presents by Walter Raines, Chairman, T. T. Deems, Clerk, and Bill Copeland, Trustees of the Friends School, District 9.

(the receipt whereof

is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said Walter Raines, Chairman, T. T. Deems, Clerk, and Bill Copeland, Trustees of the Friends School, District 9, all that certain piece of land and lot of land situated lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, Chiefly Springs Township, near the Runcomb Road, and adjoining lands of W. L. Ford, M. H. Ford West morland, and myself, more or less, being the following meters and parcels: Beginning at a stone on R. L. Ford's line, New Road Westmorland and a parcel and running thence N. 64° E. 44 P. 8 feet to an iron pin on R. L. Ford's line and line of my land; thence S. 18 1/2° W. 317.9 feet to an iron pin on line of M. H. Ford Westmorland and myself, thence West and said line N. 71 1/2° W. 312.9 feet to the beginning corner containing three-fourths (3/4) of an acre more or less, this acts to be a part of this deed that I, the said T. B. Bramlett, agree to give to the said trustees of the Friends School, District 9, and their successors, a right of way to the above described lot of land; said right of way to be as follows: Beginning at a point in the Runcomb Road which is on the line between M. H. Ford Westmorland and myself and following the said line until the above described lot of land is reached, the said right of way is not less than twenty feet wide.
