KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That S. O. Skelton

in consideration of the sum of

Ten Dollars and other valuable consideration DOLLARS,to me in hand paidat and before the sealing of these presents by W. P. Parrish and J. L. Hower

(the receipt whereof

is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

W. P. Parrish and J. L. Hower, all that lot of land situate on the east side of main street between barrier street and stone avenue, in the city and county of Greenville, South Carolina, having a frontage of sixty (60) feet on main street and running back from main street in parallel lines two hundred and ten (210) feet, more or less, to an alley, bounded on the north by W. A. Merritt, on the east by lands formerly belonging to Ellen J. Arnold, on the south by G. Thomas Arnold and on the west by main street

also all that lot or strip of land situate on the east side of north main street, in the city and county of Greenville, South Carolina, beginning on said street at the corner of lot formerly owned by Ellen J. Arnold, and running thence with line of that lot n. 70 1/2 e. two hundred and ten (210) feet, more or less, to an alley; thence along the alley toward barrier street, twelve (12) feet thence in a straight line to main street, two hundred and ten (210) feet, more or less, to a point on said street twelve (12) feet from the beginning corner; thence with said twelve (12) feet to the beginning corner.
