Gertrude T. Stoebor, her heirs and assigns, forever:-

All that certain piece, parcel and lot of land situated, lying and being in Ward Four of the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, and a subdivision known as Oakland Heights, property of W. C. Woodard, part of which is recorded in R.M.C. for Greenville County in Plat Book "C." page 147, and is Lot No 14, the North side of Lois Street:

Beginning at an iron pin 65 feet East of the intersection of Lois Street and Oakland Avenue and running thence with Lois Street S. 62. 19 E. 65 feet to an iron pin, corner of lot No. 15; thence with line of lot No. 15 N. 32. 34 E. 123. 10 feet to an iron pin corner of lot No. 8; thence with rear line of lot No. 8.
