KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That W. L. Poore, W. A. W. Bowens,
Herman W. Poore, Mary L. Poore, of Anderson County,
James E. Poore of Pickens County and cedar W.
Williams of ^{about} Laurens ^{and} Anderson, deceased
Williams of Lancaster County, the only heirs in the State aforesaid
for in consideration of the sum of
Four hundred and thirty-five (\$435.00) DOLLARS,
to me in hand paid
at and before the sealing of these presents by R. H. Eppes, of Greenville County

(the receipt whereof

is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said
R. H. Eppes, all that tract of land situated in the
County of Greenville, in said State, containing
Twenty-nine (29) acres, more or less bounded
on the North by lands of W. F. Cat Head and
lands of Marshall Eppes, and all other
lands by lands of the undersigned grantors, being
a part of a tract of land conveyed by Henry
T. Holliday and others, to James P. Poore, deceased
by deed bearing date January 4th 1882, Recorded in
Office of Register of Deeds Conveyance for Greenville
County in Book M. M. page 590, for a more particular
description of the lands here in conveyed, see
plat of same by J. M. Bay, Surveyor, dated January
15th 1906.
