is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said  
W. Wharton above named, the tract of land described as lot of land  
situated in Greenville County, of property right divided with single ownership  
of the State of South Carolina, being a part of the original division of  
the town of Greenville, 144th street and division line between the  
Piney Woods and Piney Valley and the Piney Woods and  
the following boundaries and dimensions to wit; Beginning  
at a stake set at the corner between lots 53 and 54  
and running thence along the boundary line between lots 53 and 54  
16.66 feet to a stake set at the corner between lots 53 and 56.  
Thence continuing thence of lot 53 and 56 S. 60-16 W. thence
