KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Minnie L. Watson, of Greenville County  
and in consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars and other good and valuable DOLLARS  
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J. Mark Smith

in the State aforesaid

(the receipt whereof is here-

by acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

J. Mark Smith and his heirs and assigns, all that certain piece, parcel, or lot  
 of land with the building thereon, situated, lying and being in the State of  
 South Carolina and County of Greenville, in Greenville City, in the First  
 Ward of said City, on Bunker Street, near Bragg Avenue, and having the  
 following metes and bounds, to wit:  
Begins first at an iron pipe on the south side of Bunker Street, corner  
 of G. A. Shale plot, and running thence about 5.57 1/4 ft. one hundred and six  
 (61) along said shale line to an iron pin, thence in a northerly direction  
 fifty-eight (58) feet to an iron pin, thence in a northeasterly direction  
 forty-hundred and nineteen (419) feet to an iron pipe on Bunker  
 Street, thence along Bunker Street fifty-eight (58) feet to the beginning
