by acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said James W. Locke, his heirs and assigns forever, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid on the North side of Buncombe road about one half miles from Greenville, S.C. and is a portion of the lot of land sold to J. S. Barton by Mrs. Louise B.
