by acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said Alice E. Freeman, all my right, title and interest in all that certain lot, piece, or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, and County of Greenville, in the Second Ward of the City of Greenville, on the East side of Brown Street between North and Chapel Streets, beginning at an iron pin on the East side of Brown Street and corner of lot of J. H. Hodges, and running thence with his line S. 62.6 one hundred and fifty six feet and three inches to an iron pin at Hodges' corner; thence turning left an angle of eighty four degrees and running thence with Hodges' line N. 2 1/2 E.
