WHEREAS, Mary J. Harrison, plaintiff

on or about the 13th day of September in the year of
our Lord nineteen hundred and Seventeen exhibited her
complaint in the Court
of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against

Lorenzo C. Adams, et al, defendants

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 7th
day of January 1918, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it
was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. Inman
Master in and for the County aforesaid, to Mary J. Harrison
for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; (See Judgment Roll No. _____)

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. Inman
Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree,
HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said _____

Mary J. Harrison, all that piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, South Carolina, about seven miles from the City of Greenville, on waters of Reedy Fork Creek, and the continuation of the White Horse road, beginning at a persimmon near a road, and running thence with said road north 32.40 west 16.85 to a stone, thence south 48 west 28.70 to a stone on the same well land; thence with said land south 44.40 east 17.53 to a black gum; thence north 47.50 east 25.28 to the beginning, corner and containing forty-eight acres, being the one-third interest set off to the said Mary J. Harrison by the commissioners and division of the lands of Joel B. Harrison deceased, as will appear by reference to the report of said commissioners, and is designated as lot no. 1 on plat of said land made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, February 7th and 8th, 1918.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining; and all the estate, right, title, claim and interest whatsoever, of the parties to the cause aforesaid, and of each of them in and to the same; and of all other persons rightfully claiming from, under, or any of them.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said Mary J. Harrison, her heirs and assigns forever.
