our Lord nineteen hundred and nineteen exhibited their complaint in the Court
of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against Gladys Smith, et al

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 30th
day of June 1919, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it

Hundred Dollars) all that lot of land situate in
City View in the County and State aforesaid fronting
W. M. C. A. Street 50 feet and having such courses
and distances as are shown on plat recorded in
Plat Book A, page 327 being lot no. 3 in Block
"D" of said plat.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or
appertaining; and all the estate, right, title, claim and interest whatsoever, of the parties to the cause aforesaid, and of each of them in and to the same;
and of all other persons rightfully claiming from, under, or any of them.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said J. M. Clark, his heirs and assigns forever.
