M. C. office for said County and State in Plat Book "A" page 327, said lot having a frontage of fifty feet on W. M. C. Street and running back in parallel lines to a depth of one hundred sixty feet, and being one of the lots owned Rebecca B. Dacus at the time of her death.

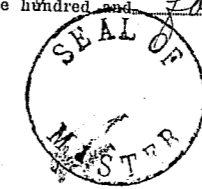
