WHEREAS, Thos. M. Hill

on or about the 29th day of February in the year of
our Lord nineteen hundred and sixteen exhibited his complaint in the Court of
Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against Thos. M. Hill, J. Louis Reid Hill
and James Coan Hill

demanding judgment in relation to the real estate hereinafter
mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 16th
day of May 1916, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a Decree
of the said Court,

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. Inman
Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00)
Dollars,
to me paid by the said Thos. M. Hill

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto
the said Thos. M. Hill the following described real estate, to wit:

"One certain piece parcel and lot of land situate
lying and being in Greenville County in the State
aforesaid, in the town of Greer, and has the following
courses, metes and bounds and distances: Beginning
at a stake on the N. side of Spring Street and beginning
thence S. 27 1/2 W. 90 feet to a stake in side ditch
street, thence N. 51 W. 200 feet to a stake, thence S. 27 1/2
E. 90 feet to a stake on new street, thence S. 51 E.
200 feet to the beginning, and contains in all
thousand square feet.

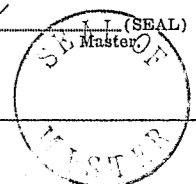
Also all that certain piece
