the said W. D. Parrish and T.C. Gower, All my undivided one-half interest in and to that cer-
tain piece, parcel or lot of land in Ward Four of the City of Greenville, County and State a-
foresaid, being lot No. 34 of "Oaklawn Heights" as shown on plat of same recorded in Plat Book
