(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said W. G. Lindsey, all that certain piece, or parcel of land in Highland Township and County and State aforesaid, Beginning at a Poplar tree at the Pruitt Spring, thence East down and with the meanders of Branch to its ford of branch to a stone, thence South east to an iron rod, thence near east to a stone, thence North East to J.L. Petty line a stone, thence North with J.L. Petty line to corner, of J.L. Petty and John Center a stone, thence west with John Center line, to stone corner of Stone Lindsey and John Center, thence South with Glover Lindsey line to the Pruitt Spring, the beginning corner and containing twenty acres more or less, and bounded, by land of J.L.
