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William A. Williams DEED TO James Birnie

in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars and other valuable considerations DOLLARS,
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by James Birnie

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto
the said James Birnie, all that certain piece of land or lot of
land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville,
County and State aforesaid and having the following metes
and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a post iron on Mountain
View Avenue, corner of Lots 14 and 15, and running thence
N. 9 $\frac{1}{4}$ E. 289 feet to a stake on a ten foot alley; thence along
said alley S. 72 $\frac{1}{4}$ E. 100 feet to a stake on said alley; thence
S. 9 $\frac{1}{4}$ W. 275 feet to a stake on Mountain View Avenue, corner of lots
15 and 16; thence W. 80-15 N. 100 feet to the beginning corner.
This lot being known as Lot #15 of Section "A" on the plat of
Trust Circle as made by J. G. Rogers in August 1911, and re-
