(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said H. P. Beam, his heirs and assigns all my right title and interest, the same being and so divided one fourth interest in and to all that certain tract of land situate in Greenville County, South Carolina, Oaklawn Township, one mile east of Elgin, on the Hall and Ford Road, and bounded by lands of Mr. G. Scott, A. B. Beam, H. P. Beam and Elgin Manufacturing Company, and known as Tract No. 1 in the plat of Survey of land of Jasper Wilson, deceased, made by Mr. G. Lee, Surveyor, on the 14th day of October, 1913, having the following lines and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an Oak 23, common corner for tracts 1, 2, 3, and running thence N. 45-1/2 E. 9.75 to rock 73 on thence 76.37-1/2 N. 31.60 to rock 73 on road leading to Greenville; thence N. 7.2-1/4 W. 22.90 to rock 73; thence S. 40-1/2 W. 3.50 to rock corner 73; thence S. 50-1/4 E. 21 to rock 73; thence S. 41-1/4 E. 30.54 to rock 73, beginning corner containing 419-1/2 acres more or less.
