to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by H. G. Gresham

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said H. G. Gresham,
I, S. O. Shelton, that tract of land situate in the County and State aforesaid, on the West side of the Augusta Road, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at an iron pin in the center of the Augusta Road and running thence 34' 31" North eight hundred and twenty-two feet to another iron pin - corner on Davenport's land, thence 17' 22" East eighteen hundred and forty-four (844) feet to another iron pin on the Augusta Road, thenceorth the Augusta Road S. 53° 30' E. one hundred and ninety-four (94) feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning and containing 18.3 acres, more or less, according to a plat, hereto attached, by C.
