(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said J. T. Leslie, his heirs and assigns, all that certaius piece, parcel or lot of land situate lying and being in the State of South Carolina and County and Township of Greenville, about two miles west of Greenville Court House, and having such metes and bounds according to a plat made by P. S. Butler, said plat is recorded in Plat Book "A" at page 307 and being Run and designated as lot #4 on the plat of New 26 acre, hereinabove referred to. Said lot having a frontage of 60 feet on Court Street and a rearing back in Parallel lines of 150 feet; thus being the same lot of land I conveyed to me by H. B.
