Now, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, John S. Henry and Cornelia Henry in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars and other consideration DOLLARS, to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by R. M. DeShazo

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said R. M. DeShazo, All those two pieces, parcels or lots of land situate and lying and being in Greenville County, South Carolina, about two and one-half miles from the County Court House and on the south of the air line Railway, near the Sandleton Road, having the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at an iron pin at corner lot number one and an alley ten feet wide and running thence with said alley south sixty feet to an iron pin on said alley thence north & west one hundred forty four feet to an iron pin on Vickers Scott's line, thence with Vickers Scott's line north 14 East fifty six and one-half feet to a corner of lot number one, thence with line of lot number one south 86 West one hundred and forty four feet to the beginning corner. Said lots are number two and three being those same lots which were conveyed to John S. Henry and Cornelia Henry by Cornelia Henry by deed recorded in S. M. C. Office for Greenville County in deed Book number 27 Page 334 and being all the real property owned by us the said John S. Henry and Cornelia Henry in that section of Greenville County popularly known as Fleetown.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said R. M. DeShazo, his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND we do hereby bind our heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said R. M. DeShazo, his heirs and assigns, against us and our heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
