(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

J. P. Meadors, all that lot or parcel of land lying, being and situated in the Town of Spartanburg, County and State aforesaid, it being a lot I purchased of W. W. Busssey on Hellams street.

Beginning at S. B. Holland's corner, running thence n 43 1/2 E. 1.19 to the S. E. Price corner, thence along the S. E. Price line n. 37 3/4 384 to stone; S. 53 1/2 W. 1.34 to stone on Holland line, thence S. 37 1/2 E. 4.15 to beginning corner survey made by J. S. Willis more fully described on a plat made by said J.
