NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Manley Bright of Greenville County in the State aforesaid

in consideration of the sum of One DOLLARS,

to wit in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Emma S. Bright of Greenville County in the aforesaid State, I

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Emma S. Bright, a certain parcel or piece of land situated in Greenville County, and State aforesaid containing twenty acres more or less lying on South Tiger River, it being a part of the George Dill place commencing at a stone on the bank of South Tiger River corner on the West side of a dream ditch running on the West side of said Ditch to the table land the use with said line to the Camp Creek road to a stone on the South side of said road on the Cabin fud-tuck line, thence a South east direction with said road to a stone thence a South direction to Wild Cat Creek to a stone thence with the meanders of said Creek to the river, thence up said river to the beginning corner

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said Emma S. Bright her heirs and assigns, forever.

heirs and assigns, against every person who may lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
